Expert teaching

The course is delivered by senior clinicians and recognised experts in PIT

The programme is underpinned by a solid empirical base. PIT is an evidence -based treatment for mental health problems including depression, medically unexplained symptoms, deliberate self-harm and personality disorder

The Improving Access to Psychological Therapies initiative (now called NHS Talking Therapies) competency framework recommends PIT as an evidence -based treatment for persistent physical symptoms

Skills based

The course aims to equip you with the knowledge and skills needed to practice PIT.

Attendance will enhance your ability to develop and maintain a therapeutic relationship. PIT skills can be used in any clinical setting or as a formal psychotherapy

Experiential Learning

Extensive use of clinical simulation, including watching therapy videos, role plays and video feedback in small group, to enhance learning and provide personal feedback

Certificate of attendance

All participants will receive a certificate of attendance, and can apply to become members of PIT-UK

This course can also lead to eligibility for Level 2 Practitioner Training in PIT

Who is the course suitable for?

Entry requirements: Qualified in a core profession in mental health, or other suitably qualified professional (at the discretion of the course directors)

The training is suited to those who:

- Have no previous knowledge of PIT but would like to learn about the model and incorporate PIT skills into their clinical practice
- Are looking to develop the knowledge and skills to practice PIT as a formal psychotherapy
- Are looking to progress to Psychodynamic Interpersonal Therapy (PIT) level 2 training and to become a PIT therapist
